Full loads (250 drums 216,5L or 50 IBC'S) as frequently as requested. When not in full loads:

- with a minimum collection of 15 steel drums (216,5L/kg), a collection will be made a maximum of 4 times per year.
- less than 15 steel drums (216,5L/kg), will be collected once per year.
- with a minimum of 8 IBC'S, a collection will be made a maximum of 4 times per year.
- less than 4 IBC'S, will be collected once per year.

pack2pack will only collect packaging with the "p2p logo" on the body.

The p2p Loop collection system guarantees a collection as defined in the p2p Loop contract between p2p and your supplier in Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Eire, France, Germany, Italy, Luxembourg, The Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland and United Kingdom.

Empty packaging collection will be in accordance with the p2p Drum Acceptance Policy (see reverse or download via www.pack2pack.com).

TERMS OF ACCEPTANCE FOR EMPTY PACKAGING

1. The packaging must be empty.
A packaging is EMPTY if all the residue, that can be removed by the emptier, has been removed by using the practices commonly employed to remove material from that type of packaging e.g. pouring, pumping, aspirating, shaking, scraping, chipping, etc., or a combination of these practices.
The costs for not being compliant to this criteria will be charged to the supplier.
2. The original labels describing packaging content must not be removed or made illegible.
3. Substances other than the original product must not be put into the packaging.
4. The packaging must be carefully and fully closed.
All original closures must be in place. For safety reasons and to prevent problems during manipulation and transport, all bungs, valves, lids and rings must be correctly applied to the packaging.
5. If the packaging contained toxic or highly irritating or odorous products, or from products that could cause problems during the treatment of the packaging, you may be asked to have these packaging decontaminated. Toxic products are those products that are classified as toxic or very toxic according to the ADR/RID (Art 2.2.61) or the EC Directive 67/548/EEG (and amendment 2001/59) and according to EC Directive 1999/45/EEG (and amendments).

T-sign:



Decontamination can mean: emptying, drip-dry conditions through ventilation, triple rinsing or chemical passivation. A dated certificate has to accompany the packaging.

pack2pack can provide you with an offer for the decontamination of packaging up to 1000 L. This offer can be requested at our commercial service.

pack2pack can not accept packaging used for radioactive substances and explosives.

6. The decontaminated packaging must be marked as such (label, stamp, ...).
7. The grading of packaging will take place at the reconditioner's site when the trailers are being unloaded and that grading is binding.
8. For packaging that does not comply with these terms of acceptance **pack2pack** has the right to charge treatment and administration costs.
